

AI UK registration FAQs

The below are the answers to some common questions.

Tickets

What is included in my ticket?

Each ticket grants you full access to the event across 23 and 24 March 2021. You will have access to all content on the virtual event platform, including two stages, the exhibition area, networking tools, chat forums and social sessions.

Can I share a ticket with my colleague?

No, your login is unique to you and cannot be used by more than one person.

Do you offer student discount?

Yes, we have a limited number of student tickets available at checkout. If these sell out, we also have an access fund where you can apply for a free ticket.

Will the talks be recorded?

Not all of them. We will record and post some key sessions on our YouTube channel after the event, but the majority of the content is only available for those attending the event.

If the event is fully booked, can I still get a ticket somehow?

Unfortunately not. This is the Turing's first national showcase and there is a limited capacity within the virtual event platform.

Do you offer a group discount for more than 6 people?

Can I change the name on my ticket?

Can I pay by invoice?
